WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR HOSPICE?

Individuals eligible for hospice services have a serious illness that their physicians have certified has a life expectancy of six months or less, and the patient and family have chosen to proceed with comfort measures only.

WHAT SERVICES DOES WELL CARE HOSPICE PROVIDE?

Well Care Hospice utilizes a team-oriented approach to expert medical care, pain management, and emotional and spiritual comfort, expressly tailored to the patient's needs and wishes. Support will also be provided for the patient's family members. At the center of hospice and palliative care is the belief that everyone has the right to die pain-free and with dignity, and that their families will receive the necessary assistance to allow them to do so. Well Care Hospice services may include a hospice physician, registered nurse, medical social worker, chaplain, hospice aide, and trained volunteers. Bereavement care and other palliative therapies may also be included.
